The World Junior Championships is owned by World Bowling.

Each edition of the championships is awarded to a host, which can be a federation, a public organization or a company. The host organizes the event in co-operation with WB's Officials.

Athletes must not have reached the age of 18 years on 1st January of the year of the championships.

The first edition of the World Singles Championships was conducted in 2019 in St Maximin, France with 58 male and 47 female athletes from 31 different federations taking part.

The championships is conducted every second year in the odd numbered years.

Each federation can send two male and two female to the championships.

The disciplines for both genders are Singles, Doubles, Team of Four(mix genders), All Event and Masters.
