In each B-Final the 6 athletes will play a Round Robin including 5 one game matches (no position round)

The bonus is 20 points for a won match and 10 points for a tied match The winner in each final is the athlete with the highest total pin fall after 5 games

Tournament tie rules

In the event of a tie in any stage prior to the Final Step 3, the athlete with the highest last game scratch will be declared the winner. If case of a further tie, the athlete with the highest penultimate game will go through. If there still is a tie, then the previous game score will be judged, and so on.

To determine the final standings after the Final Step 3 and in B-finals, it goes back to same method as before the Final Step 3 "the athlete with the highest last game scratch will be declared winner and so on".
