**Final Step 1**

48 athletes, 6 games (3+3)  
Athlete 1-30 from Qualification  
Athlete 1-4 from Early Bird  
Athlete 1-12 from the Semi Final  
Athlete 1 from Turbo 1  
Athlete 1 from Turbo 2  
Top 24 continues to the Final Step 2

**Final Step 2**

24 athletes, 4 games with the pin fall from step 1 carried forward  
Top 8 continues to the Final Step 3

**Final Step 3**

8 athletes will play a Round Robin including 7 one game matches with bonus points and one position game without bonus points  
The bonus is 20 points for a won match and 10 points for a tied match  
The pin fall from step 1 and 2 is carried forward into the round robin  
Top 3 after 18 games including bonus continues to the Final Step 4+5

**Final Step 4**

The athlete positioned 2 will play a one game match against the athlete positioned 3  
The game is starting from scratch  
The winner continues to the Final Step 5

**Final Step 5**

The athlete positioned 1 will play a one game match against the winner from Step 4  
The game is starting from scratch  
The winner of the match is the winner of the tournament

**Four different B-Finals**

Top 6 Women outside the Final Step 3  
Top 6 Juniors outside the Final Step 3  
Top 6 15+ hcp outside the Final Step 3  
Top 6 50 Seniors outside the Final Step 3  
Order of counting: Women/Seniors/Juniors/Dynamic handicap

In each B-Final the 6 athletes will play a Round Robin including 5 one game matches (no position round)  
The bonus is 20 points for a won match and 10 points for a tied match  
The winner in each final is the athlete with the highest total pin fall after 5 games

**Tournament tie rules**

In the event of a tie in any stage prior to the Final Step 3, the athlete with the highest last game scratch will be declared the winner. In case of a further tie, the athlete with the highest penultimate game will go through. If there still is a tie, then the previous game score will be judged, and so on.

To determine the final standings after the Final Step 3 and in B-finals, it goes back to same method as before the Final Step 3 "the athlete with the highest last game scratch will be declared winner and so on".
