First 300 game

For the first 300 game in the tournament, the athlete will be awarded a high performance ball. All athletes scoring a 300 game will receive a Leisureplex 300 pen.

The women's prize

The women's prize is an extra prize, which always is awarded, no matter the ranking of the highest woman in the tournament.

Seniors Prizes

The senior competition is open to athletes born on 1 January 1966 or earlier.

Age verification is required.

The senior prizes are extra prizes, which always are awarded, no matter the ranking of the highest seniors in tournament.

Tournament format

Qualification Entries, 6 games Re-entries, 6 games Desperado squad, 1 game

92 athletes will qualify for the final steps from six categories

Category A (6 athletes)

Athletes positioned 1-6 in the general qualification standing. If an athlete is qualified from A and one or more other categories; the qualification from A has the highest priority.

Category B (6 athletes)

Athletes positioned 7-12 in the general qualification standing. If an athlete is qualified from B and one or more other categories; the qualification from B has the highest priority.

Category C (4 athletes)

Athletes positioned 1-4 in a separate standing including squad 1-6.

If an athlete is qualified from C and D and/or E; the qualification from C has the highest priority.

If an athlete is qualified from C and A or B, the next positioned in the C standing will qualify.

Category D (4 athletes)

Athletes positioned 1-4 in a separate standing including squad 7-11. If an athlete is qualified from D and E; the qualification from D has the highest priority. If an athlete is qualified from D and A or B or C, the next positioned in the D standing will qualify.

Category E (68 athletes)

The 68 highest positioned athletes in the general qualification standing, not already qualified from one of the categories A, B, C or D.

Category F (4 athletes)

Athletes positioned 1-4 in the Desperado Squad.

Seeding for the Final Step 1-3

6 athletes (from category A) are seeded for the final step 3. 14 athletes (athletes from category B, C and D) are seeded for the final step 2. The 68 athletes from category E are seeded 1-68 for the final step 1. The 4 athletes from category F are seeded 69-72 for the final step 1.

Final step 1

72 athletes will play 4 games, starting from scratch Athletes positioned 1-31 are qualified for the final step 2 Athletes positioned 32-72 will be ranked 52-92 according to their position in the final step 1

Final step 2

45 athletes will play 4 games, starting from scratch Athletes positioned 1-26 are qualified for the final step 3 Athletes positioned 27-45 will be ranked 33-51 according to their position in the final step 2

Final step 3

32 athletes will play 6 games, starting from scratch Athletes positioned 1-16 are qualified for the final step 4, seeded 1-16 Athletes positioned 17-32 will be ranked 17-32 according to their position in the final step 3

Specifications for the remaining part of the final

Each step will consist of matches, decided over 2 games total pin fall. The highest seeded athlete will meet the lowest seeded athlete; the second highest seeded athlete will meet the second lowest seeded athlete etc. Athletes will keep their seeding numbers, received after the final step 3, in the remaining steps of the final.

Final step 4

8 matches

- 8 winners will continue to the final step 5
- 8 losers will be ranked 9-16 according to their seeding

Final step 5

- 4 matches
- 4 winners will continue to the final step 6
- 4 losers will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding

Final step 6

- 2 matches
- 2 winners will continue to the final step 7
- 2 losers will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding

Final step 7

1 match The loser will be ranked 2 The winner will be ranked 1

Senior Tournament format

Senior Finals Qualification Criteria

The top 4 seniors based on their ranked position after the Final Step 5, or their position in the general qualification standing, for those not qualified through to the final steps, will be seeded 1-4 for the Senior Semi Finals.

In the event that a senior athlete has also qualified for Final Step 6 then this place will go to the next senior based on the qualification criteria.

Senior Semi Final

2 matches, 2 games total pin fall to count 2 winners will continue to the Senior Final The 2 losers will be ranked 3-4 in the senior-standing according to their seeding

1 match, 2 games total pin fall to count The loser will be ranked 2 in the senior-standing The winner will be ranked 1 in the senior-standing

Tournament tie rules

Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the lowest game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the two lowest games etc.

Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

Final Step 1-3

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-3, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

Final Step 4-7 and Seniors Semi-Finals and Final

In case of a tie in a match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

The highest game

If the highest game is scored by more than one athlete, the prize will be split equally among these athletes.
