## Tournament format

## Qualification

6 games qualification (primary entries and re-entries)

## 40 athletes will qualify for the final steps

2 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 3, which is athletes positioned 1-2 in the qualification standing.
6 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 2 , which is athletes positioned $3-8$ in the qualification standing.
32 athletes will qualify for the final step 1 , which is:

- Athletes positioned 9-30 in the qualification standing
- Athletes positioned $1-4$ in the Desperado standing
- Athletes positioned 1-6 in a separate standing for the squads conducted 31 January - 3 February.
In cases of athletes from the separate 31 January - 3 February standing are positioned in the

interval 1-30 in the qualification standing, the next positioned athlete in the 31 J anuary - 3 February standing will qualify.

## Final step 1

32 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.
Top 18 will qualify for the final step 2
The athletes not continuing to the final step 2 will be ranked 27-40 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 1

## Seeding for the final step 2-5

In the final steps 2-5 athletes will be seeded according to their scores in the previous step. In step 2 the athletes 3-8 after qualification will be seeded 1-6.
In step 3 the top 2 after qualification will be seeded 1-2.

## Matching in the final step 2-5

In each of steps 2-5 there will be pools of 4 athletes
Before composing the pools the athletes will be divided in 4 equally sized groups (1-4) according to their seeding
Athletes in group 1 will be assigned to each their pool (1-N) in direct seeding order
Athletes in group 2 will be assigned to each their pool (1-N) in inverse seeding order
Athletes in group 3 will be assigned to each their pool (1-N) in direct seeding order
Athletes in group 4 will be assigned to each their pool (1-N) in inverse seeding order
In each step a pool will be assigned to a pair of lanes
Two games will be played in each step starting from scratch, total pin fall to count

## Final step 2

24 athletes (athletes positioned 3-8 after qualification and the 18 qualified from step 1) There will be 6 pools of 4 athletes
Top two from each pool will qualify for the final step 3.
Also advancing to final step 3 are two Lucky Losers, which will be the two athletes at position 3 with the highest pin fall.
The remaining 10 athletes will be ranked 17-26 according to their scores in the step

## Final step 3

16 athletes (athletes positioned 1-2 and the 14 qualified from step 2)
There will be 4 pools of 4 athletes
Top two from each pool will qualify for the final step 4
The remaining 8 athletes will be ranked $9-16$ according to their scores in the step

## Final step 4

There will be 2 pools of 4 athletes
Top two from each pool will qualify for the final step 5
The remaining 4 athletes will be ranked 5-8 according to their scores in the step

## Final step 5

There will be 1 pool of 4 athletes
The athletes will be ranked 1-4 according to their scores in the step

## Tournament tie rules

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the lowest game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the two lowest games etc.

## Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$

frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Final Step 1

Ties influencing who will qualify for the final step 2 will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

## Final Step 2-5

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step, or a tie influencing the final top 4 of the tournament, will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

For all other ties in the final step 2-4, the seeding number for the step will decide the order.
