## Final step 3 Category 1-4

3 games with the pin fall from step 1+2 and the qualification carried forward

A maximum of 4 athletes is qualified for the Final step 1

3 of them (bonus included) qualifies directly out of the qualifying rounds

1 of them qualifies through the Turbo YETJE

#### Qualification and the final step 1-2

In case of a tie, the highest ranked athlete will be the athlete with the highest last game. If a tie still exists the highest ranked athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game, then the athlete with the highest third last game etc.
