30 athletes will qualify directly for the final step 1 , which is:
Athletes positioned 21-38 in the qualification standing
Athletes positioned 1-3 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 2-3 July
Athletes positioned 1-5 in a separate standing for the squads conducted on 4-5 July
Athletes positioned 1-4 in the desperado standing
In cases of athletes from the separate 2-3 July standing is positioned in the interval 1-38 in the qualification standing, the next positioned athlete in the 2-3 July standing will qualify

In cases of athletes from the separate 4-5 July standing is positioned in the interval 1-38 in the qualification standing or 1-3 in the separate 2-3 July standings, the next positioned athlete in the 4-5 July standing will qualify

## Final step 1

30 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.
Top 10 will qualify for the final step 2
The athletes not continuing to the final step 2 will be ranked 31-50 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 1

## Final step 2

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.
Top 10 will qualify for the final step 3
The athletes not continuing to the final step 3 will be ranked 21-30 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 2

## Final step 3

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.
Top 10 will qualify for the final step 4
The athletes not continuing to the final step 4 will be ranked 11-20 according to their positions in the standing of the final step 3

## Final step 4

10 athletes will play 4 game with the total pin fall after the final step 3 carried forward Top 3 will qualify for the final step 5
The athletes not continuing to the final step 5 will be ranked $4-10$ according to their positions in the standing of the final step 4

## Final Step 5

There will be 2 stepladder matches

## Stepladder match 1

The athlete seeded 3 and the athlete seeded 2 will play a one-game match The loser of the match will be ranked 3

## Stepladder match 2

The winner of match 1 and the athlete seeded 1 will play a one-game match
The loser of the match will be ranked 2
The winner of the match will be ranked 1

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the lowest game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the two lowest games etc.

## Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Final Step 1-4

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step, and ties for any of the first 3 positions in step 4 , will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-4, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

## Final step 5

In case of a tie in any match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.
