## 40 Athletes Will Qualify For The Final Steps As Follows:

A: 4 athletes from the desperado standing
B: 1 athlete from the Turbo G6
C: 1 athlete from the Turbo G5
D: 4 athletes from a separate standing in the squads conducted on Tuesday-Wednesday
E: 30 athletes from the general standing including results from all qualification squads
An athlete will qualify only once and always from the categories in inverse order (E first).
If an athlete is qualified from more than one category, the next positioned athlete from the category not valid for the qualified athlete, will qualify in his/her place.

## Qualification for steps

Athletes positioned 1-10 in Category E will qualify for the final step 3
Athletes positioned 11-20 in Category E will qualify for the final step 2
All other athletes will qualify for the final step 1

## Final Step 1

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch
The 10 highest positioned athletes will qualify for the final step 2
Athletes not continuing to the final step 2 will be ranked 31-40 according to their positions in the final step 1

## Final Step 2

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.
The 10 highest positioned athletes will qualify for the final step 3.
Athletes not continuing to the final step 3 will be ranked 21-30 according to their positions in the final step 2

## Final Step 3

20 athletes will play 5 games starting from scratch.
The 9 highest positioned athletes will qualify for the final step 4, seeded 1-9.
Athletes not continuing to the final step 4 will be ranked $10-20$ according to their positions in the final step 3.

## Final Step 4

9 athletes will be divided in 3 groups of 3 athletes each, as follows:
Group 1: Athletes seeded 1, 6 and 7
Group 2: Athletes seeded 2, 5 and 8
Group 3: Athletes seeded 3, 4 and 9
Each group will play 2 games on one pair of lanes, total pin fall to count.
No. 1 in each group will continue to the Final Step 5.
No. 2 in each group will be ranked $4-6$ according to their seeding.
No. 3 in each group will be ranked 7-9 according to their seeding.

## Final Step 5

3 athletes will bowl 2 games on one pair of lanes, total pin fall to count.
The three athletes will be ranked 1, 2 and 3 according to their position in the step.

## Tournament tie rules

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the lowest game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest total of all counting qualification games minus the score of the two lowest games etc.

## Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Turbo

In case of tie, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest position after the qualification

## Final Step 1-3

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-3, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

## Final Step 4-5

In case of a tie between two or three players in a group, a one-ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Lane assignments and lane movements
