Desperado

1 game EU Style without previous re-dressing

24 athletes will qualify for the final steps as follows:

A: Top 14 from the general standing

B: The highest scoring athlete from squad 7-9, conducted on Thursday 22 September

C: The highest scoring athlete from squad 6, conducted on Wednesday 21 September

D: The two highest scoring athletes from squad 5, conducted on Tuesday 20 September

E: The highest scoring athlete from squad 4, conducted on Monday 19 September

F: Top 2 from a separate standing including squad 1-3, conducted on Sunday 18 September

G: Top 3 from the desperado squad

Athletes are qualified from only one category in the order A-B-C-D-E-F-G

If an athlete is qualified from more than one category, the next positioned athlete in the non-used categories of a multiple qualified athlete, will qualify in his place

Seeding for final steps

Athletes positioned 1-6 (6) in the general standing are qualified directly for the final step 3

Athletes positioned 7-12 (6) in the general standing are qualified directly for the final step 2

All other qualified athletes (12) are qualified for the final step 1

Final Step 1

12 athletes will play 3 games starting from scratch.

Top 6 will qualify for step 2.

Athletes not qualified will be ranked 19–24 according to their positions in step 1.

Final Step 2

12 athletes will play 3 games starting from scratch.

Top 6 will qualify for step 3.

Athletes not qualified will be ranked 13–18 according to their positions in step 2.

Final Step 3

12 athletes will play 3 games starting from scratch.

Top 4 will qualify for step 4.

Athletes not qualified will be ranked 5–12 in according to their positions in step 3.

Final step 4

There will be 3 stepladder matches, all starting from scratch

References to positions is to positions after the final step 3

Stepladder match 1

The athlete positioned 4 and the athlete positioned 3 will play a one game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 4

Stepladder match 2

The winner of the previous step and the athlete positioned 2 will play a one game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 3

Stepladder match 3

The winner of the previous step and the athlete positioned 1 will play a one game match

The loser of the match will be ranked 2

The winner of the match will be ranked 1

No shows for final steps

Absent athletes for final steps won't be replaced.

Absent athletes will be positioned last in the step of their absence and internally ranked ac-

ording to the order of seeding A-G as specified above.

Doubles Competition

All athletes in the tournament can take part in the Doubles Competition.

A score is valid for the doubles competition as of the squad, where an athlete is signed up to a double constellation with another athlete in the tournament secretariat.

An athlete can be signed up for a multiple number of double constellations.

The two athletes in a double constellation do not have to play in the same squad.

The highest 6 games series for each athlete in a double constellation, valid as of the squad where the doubles is registered, is counting for the 12 games score of the doubles.

Tournament tie rules

Qualification and the Final Step 1-3

In case of a tie, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest second last game etc.

Desperado

In case of a tie for position 3 in the Desperado Squad, a one ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until tie is broken.

Final Step 4

In case of a tie in any match, a one ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until tie is broken.

Doubles

In case of a tie, the highest positioned double will be the double scoring the highest last double game (2 games). If a tie still exists, the highest positioned doubles will be the double scoring the highest second last double game (2 games) etc.

Lane assignments and lane movements

Lane draws	Random impartial draws prior to all qualifying squads
Athletes per pair in squads	Maximum four
Frequency of movement	After two games
Movement method	Players on the right lane, moves right and players on the left lane, moves left
Number of lanes to move	Three pairs (6 lanes)

Booking policies

Booking restriction before	A maximum of two squads can be booked before the tournament starts
Reservations	Entry reservations, as well as re-entry reservations, without payment 24 hours before the scheduled squad time, will be taken on a first-come-first-served basis. Waiting lists will be made, when necessary.
