For a won 30 game points will be added For a tied game 15 points will be added</p> <p>Extra points, according to a game standing based on average, will be added as follows: No. 1 20 points, No. 2 16 points continuing with 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 3, 2 and 1 points</p> <p>The team with most points after the 15 games wins the tournament.</p>

<p>In case of a tie, the higher ranked team will be the team with the higher pin fall including handicap.</p> <p>Should there be another tie, the winner of the game between the two teams will be higher ranked.</p>
