## Qualification, Re-entries

One series of 3 games on the same pair of lanes
The total of the three games will, if higher, replace the lowest 3 games series

## The Turbo Competition

The highest game score, including bonus, in a 3 games series will count
Scores are only registered for those having signed up for the Turbo before each squad.
4 men will qualify directly for the final step $\mathbf{2}$ as follows:

- Athletes positioned 1-4 in the qualification standing

24 men will qualify for the final step 1 as follows:

- The 2 highest scoring athletes in the Turbo standing, not among the above qualified

8 women will qualify for the final step 1 as follows:

- Athletes positioned 1-4 in the qualification standing
- The athletes with the highest scratch series of 9 games, not qualified from top 4
- The Day-winner of Wednesday (all 3 series of 3 games the same day)
- The Day-winner of Thursday (all 3 series of 3 games the same day)
- The highest scoring athlete in the Turbo standing, not among the above qualified

6 athletes will be divided over 3 pair of lanes
On each pair of lanes, the athletes will play 2 games starting from scratch

## $5^{\text {th }}$ Final Round Men

3 athletes will play 2 games starting from scratch
The total of the two games will count to decide the winner, the runner up and no 3

## $1^{\text {st }}$ Final Round Women

8 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch
Top 6 will continue to the final step 2

## $2^{\text {nd }}$ Final Round Women

6 athletes will be divided over 2 pair of lanes
On each pair of lanes, the athletes will play 2 games starting from scratch
The total of the two games will count
The lowest scoring athlete on each pair of lanes will be eliminated

## $3^{\text {rd }}$ Final Round Women

4 athletes will be divided over 2 pair of lanes
On each pair of lanes, the athletes will play 2 games starting from scratch
The total of the two games will count
The lowest scoring athlete on each pair of lanes will be eliminated

## $4^{\text {th }}$ Final Round Women

2 athletes will play 2 games starting from scratch
The total of the two games will count to decide the winner and the runner up
