## Tournament format

## Qualification

Entry, 6 games
Re-entry, 6 games

## Turbo Game 6 competition

The standing includes the $6^{\text {th }}$ game in any 6 game series bowled by athletes having signed up for the Turbo Game 6 competition before the squad of the series has started.

## 32 athletes will qualify for the final steps

A: 22 athletes from the general qualification standing including all squads, seeded 1-22
B: 4 athletes from a separate standing including scores from Squad 1-7, seeded 23-26
C: $150+$ athlete from the $50+$ squad, seeded $27^{\text {D3) }}$
D: 1 youth athlete from a separate standing including two youth squads, seeded $28{ }^{\text {D4) }}$
E: 1 athlete from the Turbo Game 6, seeded 29
F: 3 athletes from the Elimination Roll-off, seeded 30-32 ${ }^{\text {D5 }}$
Concerning Definitions 3, 4 and 5 - see below.
An athlete will only qualify once and always from the categories in the order A-B-C-D-E-F. If an athlete qualifies in more than one category, the next positioned athlete from the next category, not valid for the already qualified athlete, will qualify.

## Draw

Draws, for the 8 groups of 4 athletes in the final step 1, and for all matches in the final step $2-4$, will be performed publicly in the centre.

## Final Step 1

32 athletes, divided in 8 groups of 4 athletes each, will bowl 5 games starting from scratch. The 2 best athletes in each group will qualify for the final step 2.
Eliminated athletes will be ranked 17-32 according to their seeding.

## Final Step 2

There will be 8 one game matches.
The 8 winners of the matches will qualify for the final step 3
The 8 losers of the matches will be ranked $9-16$ according to their seeding.

## Final Step 3

There will be 4 one game matches.
The 4 winners of the matches will qualify for the final step 4
The 4 losers of the matches will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding.

## Final Step 4

There will be 2 one game matches.
The 2 winners of the matches will qualify for the final step 5
The 2 losers of the matches will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding.

## Final Step 5

There will be a one game match.
The winner of the match will be ranked 1.
The loser of the match will be ranked 2 .

## Youth Ranking Final

The highest ranked 8 athletes in the Youth Ranking, not qualified to the main competition, will qualify for the Youth Ranking Final.

## Draw

Before the Youth Ranking Final Step 1 and 2, there will be an open draw to determine the 4, respectively 2 , matches in the two steps.

## Youth Ranking Final Step 1

There will be 4 one game matches
The 4 winners will qualify for the Youth Ranking Final Step 2
The 4 losers will be ranked 5-8 in the youth competition according to their seeding

## Youth Ranking Final Step 2

There will be 2 one game matches
The 2 winners will qualify for the Youth Ranking Final Step 3
The 2 losers will be ranked 3-4 in the youth competition according to their seeding

## Youth Ranking Final Step 3

There will be 1 one game match
The winner will be ranked 1 in the youth competition
The loser will be ranked 2 in the youth competition

## Tournament tie rules

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

## Turbo

The highest positioned athlete will be the highest positioned athlete after the qualification.

## Final Step 1

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Final Step 2-5

In case of a tie, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Definition 1: European Trick Shot Masters

8 athletes will participate.
All athletes are selected by the tournament organisation.
4 athletes will be Dutch and 4 will be international athletes.

## The Trick Shot format

All matches will be knock-out elimination matches.
All athletes are allowed to send in 10 different tricks before the tournament starts.
A toss will decide who will start the match.
The athlete does one of his tricks. Then the second bowler will have to copy the trick or get a higher count if this is the goal. If the first player fails to convert the trick than the second still has the chance to perform the trick.
A point is earned if an athlete gets a higher count or if an athlete succeeds a trick while the other athlete doesn't.
In case of a tie no point is awarded.
The first athlete to get 3 points wins the match.

## The Trick Shot Draw

Before the Quarter Finals there will be a fixed draw.
Each Dutch athlete will meet an international athlete in each Quarter Final.
A prepared bracket will decide the matching of the three steps in the competition.

## The Trick Shot Quarter Finals

There will be 4 matches
The 4 winners will qualify for the Semi Finals
The 4 losers are eliminated
The Trick Shot Semi Finals
There will be 2 matches
The 2 winners will qualify for the Finals
The 2 loses are eliminated
The Trick Shot Final
There will be 1 match
The winner will be ranked 1
The loser will be ranked 2

## Definition 2: Holland vs. The World Challenge

6 athletes will participate.
All athletes are qualified based on their position in the general qualification standing.

## Holland vs. The World Format

The first 3 Dutch and the first 3 international bowlers, who noted that they want to participate, will qualify for the Holland vs. The World Challenge.
The Dutch athletes form Team Holland and the international athletes form Team World.

## Holland vs. The World Round 1

There will be one Baker Format match
The winner can use 3 athletes in Round 2
The loser can use 2 athletes in Round 2
Holland vs. The World Round 2
Both teams select an order of play. The first athletes of each team bowl 1 shot. The lowest score is eliminated.
In case of a tie the process is repeated until the tie is broken.
The eliminated athlete is replaced by the next athlete of the team.

When all athletes of a team are eliminated the match is over.
The winner of Round 2 is ranked 1
The loser of Round 2 is ranked 2
The prize money will be split in three parts to create an equal part for each team member

Definition 3: 50+ bowlers
A 50+ bowler is a bowler who is reaching the age of 50 latest on the day before Squad 1, which is 8 September 2017.

## Definition 4: Youth bowlers

A youth bowler is a bowler, who have not yet reached (and will not reach) the age of 18 on the last day of the tournament, which is 17 September 2017.

## Definition 5: Elimination Roll-off Competition

All bowlers are allowed to enter.
Athletes not already qualified compete for the prize money and the final spots.
Already qualified athletes compete only for the prize money.

## Elimination Round 1

1 shot per athlete.
Athletes scoring 6 or less pins are eliminated.

## Elimination Round 2

1 shot per athlete.
Athletes scoring 7 or less pins are eliminated.
Elimination Round 3
1 shot per athlete.
Athletes scoring 8 or less pins are eliminated.

## Elimination Round 4

## 1 shot per athlete

Athletes scoring 9 or less pins are eliminated

## Elimination Round 5 (Final)

Remaining athletes will shoot 1 ball at the same one lane.
The athlete(s) with the lowest pin fall(s) are eliminated.
If all remaining athletes are tied then there will be another round.
This continues until there is a winner.
Qualified from the Elimination and their seeding
The highest 3 athletes not already qualified for the Final Step 1, will qualify
If there are less than 3 non-qualifiers among the last 6 athletes, there will be an extra roll-off between the last eliminated players before the final elimination round.
In case of internal ties between the 3 athletes qualified from the Elimination or in case of ties to qualify, continued rounds of shots will be performed until a ranking can be established between precisely 3 athletes.
