The $1^{\text {st }}$ Emax Open is a dual lane condition tournament
The patterns are referred to as Pattern 1 and Pattern 2
Qualification: The primary entry

The primary entry includes one squad over 4 games on Pattern 1 and one squad over 4 games on Pattern 2. The $2 \times 4$ games is added together in an 8 games qualification score.

## Qualification: Re-entries

You can re-enter on each Pattern as often as you want.
A higher total over the 4 games on a certain pattern will re-place the previous 4 games score of the same pattern.

## Two Desperado Squads

One Desperado Squad over 1 game on Pattern 1
One Desperado Squad over 1 game on Pattern 2
It is possible to bowl either one or both Desperado Squads

## 32 athletes will qualify for the final steps

A: Top 28 from the general standing, seeded 1-28
B: Top 2 from the Desperado Squad on Pattern 1 standing, seeded 29-30
C: Top 2 from the Desperado Squad on Pattern 2 standing, seeded 31-32
Athletes are qualified in the order A-B - C

## Lane conditions in all final steps

On each pair, the left lane will be dressed with Pattern 1 and the right lane with Patter 2

32 athletes will play 16 matches best of 3 games as follows:

The Loser of the matches will be ranked 17-32 according to their seeding

## Final step 2

16 athletes will play 8 matches best of 3 games on Dual Lane Condition on Pattern 1 on the left Lane and Pattern 2 on the right Lane as follows:

Match 18: Winner Match 2 vs. winner Match 15
Match 19: Winner Match 3 vs. winner Match 14
Match 20: Winner Match 4 vs. winner Match 13

## Final step 3

8 athletes will play 4 matches best of 3 games as follows:
Match 25: Winner Match 17 vs. winner Match 24
Match 26: Winner Match 18 vs. winner Match 23
Match 27: Winner Match 19 vs. winner Match 22
Match 28: Winner Match 10 vs. winner Match 21

The Loser of the matches will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding
Final step 4
4 athletes will play 2 matches best of 3 games as follows:
Match 29: Winner Match 25 vs. winner Match 28
Match 30: Winner Match 26 vs. winner Match 27

The Loser of the matches will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding

## Final step 5

2 athletes will play 1 match best of 3 games
The looser will be ranked 2
The winner will be ranked 1

## Tournament tie rules

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

## Desperado

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## All final steps

In case of a tie in any game in any match, a one-ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be played and repeated until the tie is broken.

## Lane assignments and lane movements

| Lane draws | By the tournament management |
