## Tournament format

## Groups

There will be 2 groups of each 14 teams.
Entries will be based on a first-come-first-served principle.
In case of a full pool, a waiting list will be made
The group compositions will be decided by a draw made on Fridays evening, the day before the first day of competition.
In the draw, there will be representatives from the organizer, some athletes and the company Storm represented by Bowltech France.
If two teams from the same club are drawn into the same group, the teams will be assigned to each their group. If there is three teams from the same club, there will be two teams in one group and one in the other etc.

## Competition

In each group there will be a Round Robin, where all 14 teams are meeting each of the other teams in 1 game matches, 13 matches in total.

Substitution can be made before each game, if the organizer is informed.

## Match Bonus Points

30 points is awarded for a won match and 15 points is awarded for a tied match.

## Top 5 Bonus Points

After each game, the 5 highest scoring games will be awarded Top 5 Bonus Points as follows: $1^{\text {st }} 16$ points, $2^{\text {nd }} 12$ points, $3^{\text {rd }} 8$ points, $4^{\text {th }} 5$ points and $5^{\text {th }} 3$ points.

## Standings

The standing in each group will be made up by all game scores plus women handicaps plus match bonus points plus top 5 bonus points.

## Opposition matches

After the Round Robin in the two groups, there will be 8 opposition matches to define the final positions 1-16.

The two highest positioned in the groups will bowl for positions 1-2
The two second highest positioned in the groups will bowl for positions 3-4
Etc.

## Tournament tie rules

## The standings in a group

In case of tie, the higher ranked team will be team with the higher pin fall including handicap. In case of a further tie, the winner of the game between the two teams will be higher ranked.

## The standing for Top 5 Bonus Points

If the tie is for position 1 , all are getting 16 points
A team with a score not including handicap will be higher ranked than other teams
If all tied teams have scores including handicap or all have scratch scores, tied teams are getting the same highest possible bonus

## Cash bonus

If one of the tied scores are scratch and the other scores includes handicap, the team with the scratch score will win the Cash bonus
If all tied teams have scores including handicap or all have scratch scores, the Cash bonus will be divided equally among the tied teams

## Opposition matches

In case of a tie, a 9th and 10th frame roll off, including all athletes in both teams, will be played, repeated until the tie is broken
