## Elimination Roll-Off

All athletes are allowed to enter. Non-qualified athletes will play for the extra prize and the

final spots and already qualified athletes will bowl only for the extra prize.

## First Round

All athletes will bowl 1 shot. All athletes who score 6 or less are eliminated.
Second Round
All athletes will bowl 1 shot. All athletes who score 7 or less are eliminated.
Third Round
All Athletes will bowl 1 shot. All athletes who score 8 or less are eliminated.
This will continues until we have 6 or less athletes left.

## Final Round

All remaining athletes will be assigned to 1 lane and bowl 1 shot.
The lowest scoring athlete (or athletes, if more having the same lowest score) is eliminated. This continues until there is a winner.
The top 2 non-qualified athletes will qualify for the Open Category Final.
In case of less than 3 non-qualifiers among the last 6 athletes, there will an extra roll-off between the last eliminated athletes before the final round.

## Turbo High Game competition

The standing includes the only the high game in any 6 game series bowled by athletes having signed up for the Turbo High Game Competition before the squad of the series has started.

## The Open Category final

## 32 athletes will qualify for Open Category Final

A. 25 athletes from the general qualification including all squads, seeded 1-25
B. 4 athletes from a separate standing including athletes from Netherlands, Belgium and Luxemburg
C. 1 athlete from the Turbo High Game, seeded 30
D. 2 athletes from the Elimination Roll-off, seeded 31-32

An athlete will only qualify once and always from the categories in the order A-B-C-D.
If an athlete qualifies in more than one category, the next positioned athlete from the next category, not valid for the already qualified athlete, will qualify.

## Seeded for stages

Athletes seeded 1-8 will start the final in the Knock-Out Stage
Athletes seeded $9-32$ will start the final in the Group Stage

## Draws

Draws for the 6 groups of 4 athletes in the final step 1, and for all matches in the final step 24, will be performed publicly in the centre.
Athletes seeded $9-14$ will be in Pot 1, athletes seeded $15-20$ will be in Pot 2 , athletes seeded $21-26$ will be in Pot 3 and athletes seeded $27-32$ will be in Pot 4 .

## Group Stage

24 athletes, divided in 6 groups of 4 athletes, will bowl 4 games starting from scratch.
The best athlete in each group and the two lucky losers will qualify for the Knock-out Stage. The two lucky losers are the two athletes with the highest pin fall not winning their group.

Eliminated athletes will be ranked 17-32 according to their seeding.

There will be 4 rounds of one game matches.

## Knock-Out Stage, Round 1

There will be 8 one game matches.
The 8 winners of the matches will qualify for the next stage.
The 8 losers of the matches will be ranked 9-16 according to their seeding.

## Knock-Out Stage, Round 2

There will be 4 one game matches.
The 4 winners of the matches will qualify for the next stage.
The 4 losers of the matches will be ranked 5-8 according to their seeding.

## Knock-Out Stage, Round 3

There will be 2 one game matches.
The 2 winners of the matches will qualify for the Grand Final
The 2 losers of the matches will be ranked 3-4 based to their seeding.
Both losers will receive the bronze medal.
Knock-Out Stage, Round 4 - The Grand Final
In the Grand Final there will be a one game match.
The winner of the match will be ranked 1.
The loser of the match will be ranked 2 .

## Tournament tie rules

## Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

## Turbo

The highest positioned athlete will be the highest positioned athlete after the qualification.

## Elimination Roll-Off

All athletes with the same lowest score will be eliminated if at least one athlete has bowled a higher score than the tied athletes.
If it occurs that all athletes are tied, then all athletes moves on and bowl another round.

## Group Stage

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Knock-out Stage

In case of a tie, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.
