An average handicap will be calculated as 70% of the difference between 180 and the average till a maximum of 48 pins per game.

The highest possible game score incl. all kind of handicaps is 300.

4 athletes will qualify for the final steps as follows:

The U16 standing is based on the general standing including squad 10, 11 and 17. Athletes positioned 1-4 in the U16 standing is qualified for the Final Step 1, seeded 1-4

Matches in the Final Step 1-2

The highest seeded athlete vs. the lowest seeded athlete, the second highest seeded athlete vs. the second lowest seeded athlete etc.

Final Step 1

There will be 2 matches, 2 games total pin fall to count

Qualification: All Categories, excepts U16

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game, then the athlete scoring the highest second last game etc.

Qualification: Only U16

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the lowest handicap. In case of a further tie the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game, then the athlete scoring the highest second last game etc.

Desperado Squad

A tie influencing who will qualify for the first final step will be broken by playing a one ball roll of on a full set of pins, repeated until the tie is broken.

Turbo 2 and 5

The highest positioned athlete will be the highest positioned athlete after the qualification.

Final Step 1-3: The Main Event

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game, then the athlete scoring the highest second last game etc.

All matches in the Main event (4-6) and finals for category B, C and Seniors

A one ball roll of on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Final for U16

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the lowest handicap. In case of a further tie a one ball roll of on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.
