<p><b>Number of finalists in each Category</b>            Max 8 in Category 1, Mixed under 13            Max 8 in Category 2, Boys under 16            Max 8 in Category 2, Girls under 16            Max 8 in Category 3, Boys under 19            Max 8 in Category 3, Girls under 19            Max 8 in Category 4, Boys under 25            Max 8 in Category 4, Girls under 25</p> <p><b>Step 1: Qualification</b>            In each Category, the athletes will play 6 games starting from scratch            Top 4 in each category will continue to Step 2</p> <p><b>Criteria for Step 2 and 3</b>            The format is valid for all Categories            Each step will start from scratch</p> <p><b>Step 2: Semi-Finals</b>            Athlete 1 will play athlete 4 and athlete 2 will play athlete 3 in match of best of 3 games, the first athlete to win two games in each match advances to step 3</p> <p><b>Step 3: Finals</b>            2 athletes will play one match, best of three games – the first to win 2 games is the winner.</p>

<b>Tournament tie rules</b>
<p><b>The Final Step 1</b>            In case of a tie, the athlete with the highest last game will be highest ranked. In case of a further tie, the athlete with the second highest last game will be highest ranked etc.</p> <p><b>The Final Step 2 and 3</b>            In case of a tie among two or more athletes, for a position which is decisive for a continuation to the next final step, one shot roll off will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.</p>

### Other information

#### Athletes area

Only athletes in competition and tournament officials will be allowed in the athlete's area.

#### Additional area for coaches

A special coach area will be established about 30 cm from the athlete's area.

To get access to the coach area, the coach must (a) have a bowler in action in the final step, and (b) report to the head referee of the tournament to get a badge, which must be worn in a visible way, as long as the coach is in the coach area.

To get a badge for the coach area, the coach must be licensed in one of the following ways:

- Nationally (Coaching license: Instructor, Coach level A or B, or level 1, 2 or 3)
- USBC Bronze Silver or Gold
- ETBF Level I, II or III

All coaches who want to qualify for a badge must do that before the beginning of a step and always by documenting their coach education by a license.

Coaches in the Coach area must be presentably dressed.

#### Slow bowling

To use a two lane courtesy is not allowed during the entire tournament.

#### Dress code for athletes

Wearing bowling dress is required for athletes during all steps of the tournament as well as during the prize ceremony.

Bowling dress is for instance nice trousers for boys and skirts or long/short neat trousers for girls. Or for example sportswear for boys and girls.

Wearing jeans, sweatpants, joggers (boys or girls) and/or hats of any kinds is not allowed. Failure to comply with this rule will give you a fine of 10 €.

#### Liabilities

Athletes, coaches, parents and guardians are responsible for their equipment.

Place the equipment in designated areas or out of the pathways.

The organisation is not liable for the loss or damage to bowling equipment or related matters.

It is the responsibility of the athletes, coaches, parents and/or guardians to comply with the policy of the bowling centre concerning consumption of self-supplied food and drinks; this is not allowed.

It is not allowed to eat or drink in the athlete's area.

**An oath for fair play**

The tournament will be opened by an oath, which will underline good sportsmanship and fair play during the event. The oath will be taken by a bowler, a parent, a coach and an organiser.
