Round 2

All age groups will play 3 games with the pin fall from Round 1 carried forward. Top 4 from each group qualifies to Round 3.

Round 3:

For each age group there will be 3 one game Round Robin matches. 20 points will be added for a won game and 10 points for a tied game.

Other tournament rules

- 1. All athletes must be current members of their National Bowling Federation and must present a current membership card when registering for the tournament.
- 2. All squads are mixed age groups. Please indicate on age group you are participating in. The athletes must be under the specified age group on 1 September 2023.
- 3. The athletes must sign the official scoresheet. Unsigned sheets will not be accepted and the scores will not be added to the running total.
- 4. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute which cannot be settled on the spot.
- 5. Only competitors and officials are allowed in the bowling area. Parents and coaches must remain in the spectator's area.
- 6. Any individual, whose conduct is considered to be derogatory to the best interest of the sport on or off the lanes during the tournament, will be reported to their National Bowling Federation and may be disqualified for the rest of the tournament. Any athlete found to be under the influence of alcohol will be disqualified from the tournament.
- 7. The Tournament Manager will allow no unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Should a bowler refuse to proceed with a game after being directed to do so by the Tournament Manager, such game shall be deemed void.
- 8. Entries will only be accepted with entry fee and will be on first come first served basis.
- 9. The Tournament Manager will be Sean Kennedy.
- 10. Tournament Committee: Nicola Staines & Tracey Fox.

Tournament tie rules

Round 1-2

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

Round 3

In case of a tied position, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.
