Tournament format All four categories follow the same format. Qualification Entry = 6 games - Re-Entry = 6 games. Only the highest series of 6 games will count – max 2 re-entries. 21 athletes in each category will qualify for the final steps Athletes positioned 1-7 in the qualifications are qualified for the final step 2. Athletes positioned 8-21 in the qualifications are qualified for the final step 1. Players who don't advance to final step 1 will be ranked according to their highest qualification series score. SUNDAY Final Step 1 : 12:00 – 14:00 14 athletes in each category will play 4 games starting from scratch. Top 7 in each category will qualify for the Final step 2. Players who don't advance to final step 2 will be ranked according to their final step 1 score. Final Step 2 : 14:00 – 16:00 14 athletes in each category will play 4 games starting from scratch. Top 4 in each category will qualify for the final4. Players who don't advance to the final4 will be ranked according to their final step 2 score. Final4 – One game matches, starting from scratch 16:00 – 16:30 – Semi-Final. 1st vs 4 th (A) & 2nd vs 3 rd (B) Winners advance to the final, defeated players are 3rd and 4th based on their semi-final scores. 16:30 – 17:00 – Final. Winner A vs winner B Winner of the match wins the tournament, the lowest scoring athlete will be runner-up. Award ceremony – 17:00

Tournament tie rules Qualification & Final Steps: In case of a tie, the athlete with the highest score in the most recent game ranks higher. If still tied, the next most recent game is used, and so on.

Final4:

If there's a tie in a stepladder match, a one-ball roll-off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Booking policies

Booking restriction before	Maximum 1 entry & 1 re-entry, first come, first served basis. Registrations will be confirmed upon payment. Athletes from outside France are eligible to make reservations in advance. The organization will ensure sufficient spots for French players.
Booking restriction during	An extra (3rd) entry can be booked during the tournament if spots are available. The 2nd re-entry can only be booked once the re-entry has been played.
